We invite you to participate in the International Scientific and Practical Conference, which will be held **on January 29, 2025**, at the State Organization "Institute for Economics and Forecasting of the National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine."

Purpose of the event: highlight the scientific legacy of the prominent Ukrainian economist and statesman Mykhailo Tuhon-Baranovsky and to promote the creative development of his scientific ideas to address global challenges facing Ukraine's economy, state, science, and society.

Format: plenary session and discussion panels in a mixed format (in-person and online) in Kyiv. In-person participation will take place in the conference hall of the SO "Institute for Economics and Forecasting of the National Academy of Sciences of Ukraine." Online participation will be hosted on the **Zoom platform**.

Working languages: Ukrainian, English.

In the registration form, attach the file with your abstracts (named with the first author's last name: Ivanenko_I_Abstracts).

Requirements for abstracts:

- Prepared in Microsoft Word (*.doc, *.docx).
- Up to 5 full pages in A4 format in Ukrainian or English.
- Margins: 20 mm on all sides; Font: Times New Roman, size 14, line spacing 1.5 pt, paragraph indent 1.25 mm.
- References should be cited in square brackets – [2, p. 48]; the list of references should follow the order of appearance in the text.
- Bibliographic descriptions must comply with DSTU 8302:2015 (details at [link](#))

Sequence of content in abstracts:

1. Author(s)' name(s) (bold, right alignment).
2. Academic degree, title, position, affiliation (right alignment).
3. Title (uppercase, bold, centered) – one paragraph space before the text.
4. Abstract text – one paragraph space after the title.
5. References (bold, centered) – one paragraph space before the list.
6. Save the file in RTF or DOCX format.

Authors are responsible for the accuracy of the information, citations, and references.

The organizing committee reserves the right to reject materials that do not meet the requirements or are submitted after the deadline.

Participation in the conference and electronic publication of materials are free of charge.

Registered participants will receive the program and organizational information prior to the conference. Electronic certificates can be provided upon request.

In case of unforeseen circumstances, participants will be informed about any changes to the event format.
