Dear colleagues!

On December 11, 2025 the Institute for information recording of the National academy of sciences of Ukraine will host the XXV International scientific and practical conference "Information technologies and security" (ITS-2025). https://its.ipri.kiev.ua

Representatives of academia, higher educational establishments, state authorities, government, business, and other spheres interested in the conference topics are welcome to participate. The event aims to facilitate exchange of experience, strengthening of cooperation, discussion of issues related to Information technologies and security, especially, the latest research in the area of Computer science, and to ensure compliance of academic studies with modern international standards.

The conference will be held in online mode.

The conference program will focus on but not be limited to the following topics:

- Security and Survivability of Critical Infrastructures;
- Artificial Intelligence Technologies and Data Science;
- Analytical Systems Based on Open Source Intelligence;
- Computer Modelling of Complex Systems;
- Modelling, Analysis and Forecasting of Network Interaction Processes;
- Intelligent Technologies for Decision-making Support.

Those wishing to participate in the conference need to register and submit their extended abstracts no later than December 5, 2025 using the following form: https://its.ipri.kiev.ua/#register

Extended abstracts, accepted by the program committee and presented at the conference, will be published in the conference book of extended abstracts.

Please carefully study the requirements for submitting and formatting extended abstracts below. Failure to comply with these requirements and deadlines may result in rejection of your publication!

Extended abstract submission requirements:

- The extended abstract should contain original, completed and previously unpublished results of scientific research in the field of Computer Science.
- Registration and submission of extended abstracts should be performed exclusively through the respective registration form available at the conference website (https://its.ipri.kiev.ua/#register).
- Extended abstracts submitted in any other format or means (e.g. via email) will not be taken into consideration.
- The corresponding author should register and submit the extended abstract using his/her Google account.
- Only one extended abstract can be registered and submitted from one Google account.
- After the registration and before closing the form the corresponding author can review and edit submitted information, authors data, and update the extended abstract versions.
- Note that the extended abstracts file name must consist exclusively of a list of the surnames of all its authors in English (e.g. Ivanenko.docx, Petrenko_Sydorenko.docx)! Note that the file name must not contain any other words or symbols (e.g.: ITS-2025-Ivanenko.docx, Petrenko_Sydorenko_2025.docx, IpriConf_2025.docx, Sidorov(1).docx)! There is no collision of matches with the names of previously uploaded files in Google forms.

- The list and order of authors in the extended abstract and file name must match the information entered in the Google form during registration.
- It is possible to update the version of the extended abstract file before the deadline (follow the link to the Google form → follow the link "Change your answer" → click the "Add file" button → upload the corresponding updated paper file → click the "Submit" button).
- Extended abstract should include the following mandatory structural elements: UDC, paper title, author's name and surname, ORCID of the author(s), every author's organization name, city, country, e-mail of the author(s), abstract and keywords. Extended abstract text should be structured and divided into sections, including introduction, conclusions and references.
- The extended abstract should be prepared strictly in accordance with the template (the file "ITS-2025_Extended_Abstract_Template.docx" is attached to this email), which should be used as the basis of the extended abstract file, and not copied into another file.
- The size of the extended abstract should be 2, 3 or 4 full pages, including references. It is recommended to include up to 5 references in the reference list.

The program committee will select the best works from among the extended abstracts, presented at the conference, and recommend their authors to prepare full-text papers which will be submitted for publication in the international academic publication repository CEUR Workshop Proceedings (https://ceur-ws.org), which is indexed in the scientometric database Scopus (https://www.scopus.com). Papers that successfully pass the revision process should meet the requirements of CEUR. Particularly, CEUR only accepts papers in English, and expects author teams to include international collaborations, where each author has at least 5 publications featured in the "Computer Science" publication database – DBLP (https://dblp.org).
